Thank you all so much for your prayers for Scott Brown. As you will recall he was having trouble getting the immigration dept to deal with their application for residency in NZ. After our prayer request the immigration dept paid an unannounced visit to the Dansies Pass camp site to assess their situation. This led to 10 pages of reasons why they could not stay in NZ. Scott responded to each issue and within 2 weeks the immigration dept granted them residency. The camp owner was threatening to evict them because they could not secure their loan until they had residency, but after our prayer began he softened dramatically. We have heard today that the camp purchase has gone through smoothly and the family have been able to have a day out in Dunedin today for the first time in 2 years as they are now the camp owners and can plan their own days.



Praise the Lord indeed, and thank you Rosedale from Scott and his family. They have cherished our prayer support.
