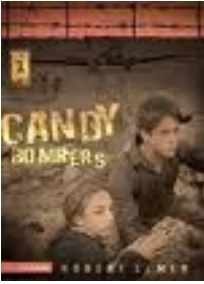
The camp will be held on the 19th – 21st March and camp registrations are available in the church foyer with all the information you need.
